In the center is Panfilov Park, home to the bright-yellow towers of Zenkov Cathedral, a tsarist-era Russian Orthodox church.

DAY 3 ALMATY - MEADOWS & SHYMBULAK TOUR FOLLOWED BY GALA DINNER

- Transfer to excursion at 10:30 Hrs
- This tour provides you the best opportunity to see the beautiful mountain surroundings of Almaty city. The first stop of the tour awaits you in the Meadow Gorge, where in the wonderful mountains of Trans-Ili Ala-Tau the largest high mountain skating rink in the world is located as well as the huge dam, protecting the city from destructive mudflows formed on the tops of the western Tien Shan. Next destination is Shymbulak ski resort (Cable Car Fee Included), located at an altitude of 2230 meters above sea level. It is very popular for its mild climate, large quantity of sunny days and snow through the winter and remarkable scenery of mountain ranges.

DAY 4 ALMATY – KOLSAI LAKE TOUR FOLLOWED BY CHARYAN CANYON TOUR

- Breakfast 0700-0730 Hrs
- **0800 Hrs Proceed for Kolsai Lake Tour**
- Proceed for Kolsai Lakes are a group of three picturesque alpine lakes located in the Almaty region of Kazakhstan, near the border with Kyrgyzstan. The lakes are part of the Kolsai-Kolderi National Park, which covers an area of about 16,800 hectares.
- The Kolsai Lakes are renowned for their crystal-clear turquoise waters, surrounded by dense coniferous forests, meadows, and snow-capped peaks. The area is rich in biodiversity, with various plant and animal species, including rare and endangered ones. The lakes and their surroundings offer excellent opportunities for hiking, trekking, camping, and photography.
- To visit Kolsai Lakes, you typically need to travel from Almaty, the largest city in Kazakhstan. The journey takes approximately 3-4 hours by road, covering a distance of around 330 kilometres (205 miles).
- It's important to note that due to the pristine nature of the Kolsai Lakes and the national park, there are regulations in place to preserve the environment. Visitors are expected to follow guidelines, such as not littering, not camping in prohibited areas, and respecting the flora and fauna.
- Overall, Kolsai Lakes offer a breathtaking natural retreat for outdoor enthusiasts and nature lovers, providing an opportunity to experience the beauty of Kazakhstan's alpine landscapes.
- **Transfer to Restaurant for Lunch (Meals own by Guests)**
- Post Lunch Proceed for Charyan. The canyon formation is along the banks of the fast-flowing Charyan River in a northern flow stretch of about 80 kilometres, which is a tributary of the Ile River; the river has a total length of 393 kilometres. The river rises from the Tian Shan Mountains that is spread over the arid semi-desert to the east of Almaty. In parts, it attains a depth of 150 to 300 metres. The geological formation of the canyon is of sedimentary red sandstone which has been subject to the "autogenic process" of water and wind erosion resulting in "weird and colourful formations" in the form of sculptures.
- Return to Almaty City.
- **Proceed for Dinner at Indian Restaurant**
- Drop back to hotel.
- Free time – can explore night activities at your own

- Overnight at Almaty
